Linguine or Spaghetti in White Clam Sauce

Ingredients:

24 little neck clams (scrub shells thoroughly) % cup olive oil 4 cloves of garlic sliced % cup white wine Few leaves of fresh basil Crushed red pepper (to taste) 1 pound pasta (linguine or spaghetti) Chopped fresh parsley (to garnish)

Directions:

In a deep fry pan combine oil, garlic and red pepper. Sautee until the garlic is lightly golden. Add clams and basil and cover tightly for approximately 2 minutes. Add wine and put the lid back on cooking for an additional 4 minutes or until the clamshells open.

Bring a large pot of water to boil. When boils, add pasta and salt (to your liking). Cook according to package directions.

When pasta is finished cooking, drain the pasta and mix with clam sauce. Place open clams on top, drizzle with a little olive oil and sprinkle parsley for garnish.
